

BIRTH CONTROL BILL OF RIGHTS

You have the right to your birth control of choice.

The decision on why, if, and what birth control to use is yours. We'll discuss your options together to help you decide - don't be afraid to ask questions!

You have the right to get reproductive care on your own.

Anyone in Illinois that is 12+ can get confidential STIs testing and birth control on their own without parent or guardian consent.

You have the right to a year supply of birth control.

Most insurance covers a year's supply of the pill, patch, or ring with a single pharmacy pickup. Tell your provider if you're interested in a year supply of birth control - as long as there are no clinical concerns, they'll write you a prescription.

You have the right to emergency contraception (EC).

EC prevents pregnancy for individuals who are not currently pregnant. We can write you a prescription for the EC pill so you have it on hand. You can also ask us about the IUD which works as EC and ongoing, hassle-free birth control.

You have the right to affordable birth control.

If you have Medicaid, your birth control is fully covered. Let us know if you have concerns about cost - we'll work with you to get your birth control for low or no out-of-pocket cost.

You have the right to decide if, when and under what circumstances to be pregnant and to parent.

If you find yourself pregnant, you have three options: abortion, prenatal care to parent, or prenatal care for adoption. We'll give you facts on all options and let you decide what's best for you.
