

Routine screening for contraceptive needs and desires



REMINDER

Patients of reproductive age should be screened during primary care visits. Screening should be documented in the EMR using Z30.09 or Z30.XX for method specific counseling.



PATH: Parenting/pregnancy attitudes, timing & how important

- Do you think you might like to have (more) children at some point?

OKQ: One Key Question

- Would you like to become pregnant within the next year?

SINC: Self-identified need for Contraception

- We ask everyone about their reproductive health needs. Do you want to talk about contraception or pregnancy prevention during your visit today?

Your role in establishing routine screening as a standard of primary care:

- Support patients to decide if and when to become pregnant/parent.
- Encourage timely preconception and/or STI care.
- Support health center UDS reporting for contraceptive screening (new in 2024).
- Help capture revenue under the HFS FPP/FPPE.
