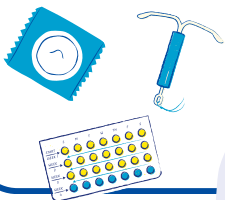


Patients of reproductive age should be screened for contraceptive needs and desires alongside STI and HIV education and prevention during primary care visits:

**Contraceptive Screening Questions**

- PATH: Do you think you might like to have (more) children at some point?
- One Key Question: Would you like to become pregnant within the next year?
- Self-identified need for Contraception: Do you want to talk about contraception or pregnancy prevention during your visit today?

Document **Z30.09** (general contraceptive screening) or **Z30.XX** (method specific code) to capture revenue under Medicaid FPP/FPPE and get credit for UDS reporting.

**Practice Pearls**

EC Pills: Rx in advance, if > 165 lbs- Rx Ella      Z30.012      Z30.012      S4993

Screen for STI per guidelines and offer or Rx ext/int condoms (#30 per month covered by Medicaid)

Conversations on birth control, STI, and HIV care should always go hand-in-hand. Use the 5 P's to get started:

**Partners:** Are you having sex? How many/gender of your partner(s)?

**Practices:** What kind of sex do you have/what body parts do you use?

**Protection from STIs:** How often do you use condoms?

**Past history of STIs:** Have you been tested for STIs or HIV? When?

**Pregnancy Intention:** See reverse for recommended screening questions.

A60: Herpes
