Screening patients for Medicaid, including Medicaid Family Planning, eligibility before applying available grant dollars expands access to no-cost services by preserving grant dollars to serve the truly un/underinsured and supports health center sustainability.

MEDICAID FOR FAMILY PLANNING *HFS FPP/FPPE*

Open to IL residents of:

- Any age
- Any gender
- Individual income \leq \$3,841/mo
- People with private insurance
- No questions about citizenship or immigration for immediate, temporary FPPE coverage.

No cost:

- Annual check-up
- All birth control methods
- STI care including HIV screening and prevention (PrEP/PEP)
- Preventive services (repro vaccines, mammogram)
- Gynecological care (pap, colpos)
- Preconception care

- **Apply** for 12-months of coverage through ABE or for FPPE with designated providers.
- **Access** care, supplies/meds at any health entity that accepts Medicaid.

ILLINOIS FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAM: *ILFPP (TITLE X)*

Open to people of any immigration status or state residency of:

- Any gender
- Ages 12+
- Household income \leq 100% FPL for no-cost care, 101-250% for sliding fee discounted care

Low or no cost:

- All birth control methods
- STI care
- Gynecological care (pap)
- Preconception services
- Care coordination for other reproductive/primary care services.

- **Apply** for and access care at any Title X grantee clinic site.
- **Access** supplies/meds at Title X grantee clinic site.

RYAN WHITE

Open to Illinois residents of:

- Any gender
- Income \leq 500% FPL
- HIV or AIDS diagnosis

No cost assistance for:

- Medication
- Health insurance premium
- Rent and mortgage
- Medical case management

- **Apply for and access** support at any Ryan White grantee clinic or agency.

PREP4ILLINOIS

Open to IL residents of:

- Any gender
- At risk for HIV and have a prescription for PrEP
- Any income

No cost:

- Truvada
- Descovy
- Apretude (with pre-approval; does not cover injection fee)

- **Apply** at prep4illinois.com by completing online application.

ILLINOIS BREAST & CERVICAL CANCER PREVENTION PROGRAM *IBCCP*

Open to Illinois women:

- Ages 21-64
- Uninsured or underinsured

No cost:

- Mammograms
- Breast exam
- Pelvic exams
- Paps

- **Apply** with IBCCP agency or by calling the IDPH Women's Health Line (888-522-1282).
