

You might already have insurance!

Good news, you qualify for coverage through the Medicaid Family Planning Program (FPP), a partial Medicaid benefits program that allows you to access a range of primary and preventative care services at no cost.

✓ In addition to your visit being free, you can also get any of the following services and medications at no cost:

- Physical exam
- STI testing/treatment and condoms
- HIV testing, PEP, and PrEP
- COVID, HPV, Hepatitis, and mpox vaccines
- Preconception care, counseling, and labs
- Birth control (pill, patch, ring, Depo, implant, IUD)
- Emergency contraception
- Tubal ligation or vasectomy
- Mammograms, pap smears/pap follow-up
- Treatment for genital/urinary infections



✓ Here's what you should know about your FPP Coverage

- **Coverage is confidential**, zero out of pocket cost for services under Medicaid Family Planning.
- You likely got this coverage because **you recently applied for full Medicaid but were not eligible**. Ask your provider to confirm your coverage status and help you understand your benefits. **If you or a family member experience a change in income, you can apply again for full benefits at any time.**
